The **containing** operator finds whole sentences which contain certain tokens, words or grammatical or lexical structures defined by CQL. The whole sentence will be highlighted as KWIC.



To find sentences containing ellipsis indicated with three dots (...), use:

<s/> containing [ word="\.\.\." ]

**Note:** Normally, a dot is a regular expression meaning 'any character'. Three dots ... would mean 'a word composed of any three letters'. To cancel this special function of the dot, a backslash needs to come before each one. This is called **escaping**. All three dots are escaped.
